### CHAPEL OFFERING

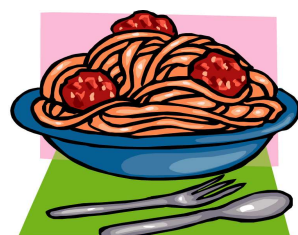

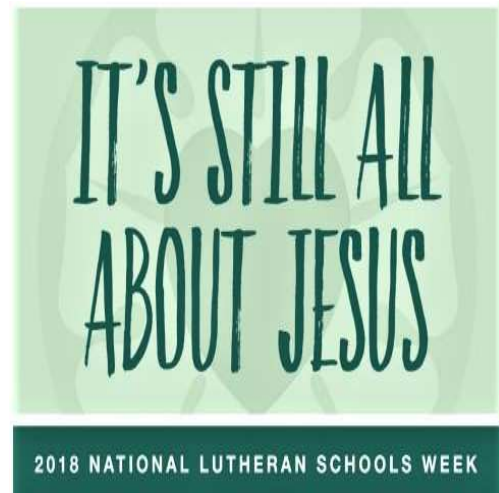

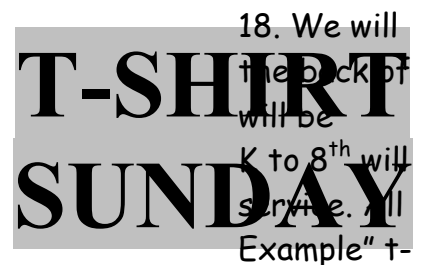
### ST. PAUL SPRING CARNIVAL

Packets have been handed out for a couple weeks. Science Fair projects are due March 13th. Please let Mr. Korotka know if you have any question

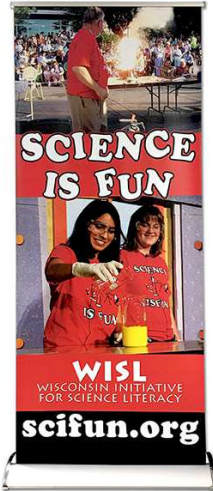
**3rd and 4th Grade** Rachel Beyer - Extension 1023 -message through FastDirect
