

Dear Parents/Guardians of the 4th through 8th grade Girls and 7th/8th grade Boys:

St Paul Lutheran School will conduct a scoliosis screening program on Thursday, May 2nd. The purpose of the program is to detect possible curvature of the spine in children. If the condition is detected early and appropriately treated, progressive spinal deformity may be prevented. Traditionally, adolescents were screened only once or twice during their growth period. However, I strongly believe that because of the nature of the slow changes in scoliotic curving, our students need to be screened annually to ensure early detection of any changes.

The screening test is very simple and can be performed in approximately one minute. I will check your child's back by observing it while your child is standing and bending forward. You will be contacted if there is any reason to have your child examined by your health care provider.

Girls and boys will be screened separately to ensure privacy. To assure a view of the spine, we may request that students expose their backs during screening. At most we will raise the shirt to the mid back without exposing the front.

If your child is currently under treatment for a spinal deformity, please let us know, and your child will be exempt from the screening process.
